



QUESTIONS ABOUT YOUR REGISTRATION?

Here are some commonly asked questions from parents that are new to organized sports and soccer. Please contact info@cityscsanmarcos.com if you have any other questions after reading this document.

- **WHEN WILL MY CHILD GET A CALL?** Your child will actually get an email from the League when rosters are released to the coaches. The email will have your child's team information.
- **WHEN DO THE COACHES GET THEIR TEAMS?** Coaches will receive their team roster prior to the start of the season via email or at the pre-season Coaches' Meeting.
- **WHEN DO PRACTICES BEGIN?** For the fall season, practices will begin the first week of August. After the coaches received their teams, they will email or call their players with practice information. For the spring season, there are no practices.
- **HOW OFTEN ARE PRACTICES?** For the fall season, teams typically practice 2 or 3 times per week – depending on the age group. Younger divisions might practice twice per week until games begin, at which time they might go to once per week. But it is up to the coach and the flexibility of the players. For the spring season, there are no practices.
- **WHERE ARE PRACTICES?** Practices are held at league approved parks and schools as allocated by the City of San Marcos. Your child's coach will decide at which field your practices will be.
- **WHAT EQUIPMENT DOES MY CHILD NEED?** Shin guards are required to play soccer. Socks must cover the entire shin guard. Soccer shoes (cleats) are not required but are recommended – especially at the older divisions. Football and baseball cleats are NOT allowed in soccer – make sure you have soccer cleats.
- **WHEN DO GAMES BEGIN?** For the fall season, the first regular season game is sometime in August. For the spring season, the first game is sometime in February.
- **HOW OFTEN ARE GAMES?** For the fall season, games are played every Saturday except for Labor Day Weekend. For the spring season, all games are played every Saturday, except Easter Weekend.
- **WHERE ARE GAMES PLAYED?** Our home field for the fall season is Walnut Grove Park. Our home fields for spring season are Sunset Park, Bradley Park, and Connors Park.
- **CAN MY KIDS BE ON THE SAME TEAM AS THEIR FRIENDS?** Friend requests will be honored for certain volunteer positions. For more information, visit the homepage of our website and click on the link to download a friend request form.
