

# CITY SC SAN MARCOS FINANCIAL AID PROGRAM

The City SC San Marcos financial aid program is intended to help those families that cannot afford the full registration fees for their children to play soccer. We provide an opportunity for a reduced registration rate and in return require the recipient parent and/or player to volunteer for our organization. The required amount of volunteering will vary, but generally will range between 4-12 hours.

If the volunteer requirement is not met, the player's card will be withheld.

Please complete the following application for financial aid consideration. Applications will not be processed without the income resources for the family of the applicant. Financial aid is partial. The remainder must be paid or sponsored.

Below are the volunteer categories to choose from:

### 1. Parent Volunteer

Parents may volunteer for club activities such as Opening Day, Fundraising Events, Tournaments, etc.

#### 2. Field Preparation

Help prepare the field on game day by placing goals, placing corner flags, etc. May include setting out parking signs, portable trash containers, etc.

#### 3. Field Teardown

Help put away goals, corner flags, easy-ups, collecting and storing the parking signs, trash containers, etc.

#### 4. Team Manager

Team managers will assist the coach with coordinating team events such as tournaments and team fundraisers. They will also collect team funds to turn in to the league and keep track of team account balances.

 Help prepare & tear down the fields by placing goals, placing corner flags, etc. May include setting out parking signs, portable trash containers, parking attendant etc.
